WELCOME TO SUZANNE PENCE, NEW CHOIR DIRECTOR

Exciting news from Fr. John:

“We have hired Dr. Suzanne Pence as our new choir director. Her first official Sunday will be January 21, but she will not conduct that day. Jack Walton, our interim director, will, and we will celebrate his ministry after the service. Suzanne inherits a choir that is gifted, faithful, and ready to keep growing. I am so grateful for Jack, for Gena, who is always such a staple of this choir and church, and for all of the singers. I am also excited about our future, and that future is very bright!”

Suzanne M. Pence is Associate Professor of Music and Human Learning in the Butler School of Music at The University of Texas-Austin where she has been teaching since 1996. She teaches courses in conducting and choral music education. Dr. Pence was the conductor of the Concert Chorale from 2000-2021 and has also conducted the Treble Chorus, University Chorus, and Choral Arts Society. She most recently started a Treble Chamber Choir that performs early music repertoire through vocal jazz. Under Pence’s direction, the Concert Chorale has toured throughout the southern United States, performed for the Southwest American Choral Directors Association, and at Carnegie Hall in New York. She received the DMA in Choral Conducting from the University of Missouri-Kansas City where she studied with Drs. Eph Ehly and Charles Robinson, a Master of Music Education degree from Wichita State University where she studied with Dr. René Clausen, and a Bachelor of Music Education degree from Millikin University in Decatur, Illinois where she studied with Richard Hoffland. Pence is currently the College and Community Vice President of TCDA and is also a member of ACDA and TMEA. She is an active adjudicator/clinician and festival conductor throughout the country. Suzanne has a son and daughter, both married and living in Austin, and her hobbies include hiking, trying to play golf, reading, and traveling.



Dr. Pence says she is “looking forward to working with the 11:00 am choir and getting to know the St. Michael’s community.” She adds her gratitude for Jack, Gena, and the choir to Fr. John’s.

Tuesday Women's Bible Study: First Corinthians | Starts January 9 The Women's Bible Study will begin a new topic on Tuesday, January 9, at 6 pm: 1st Corinthians. Christianity calls us to sacrifice instead of living for oneself. The Christians in Corinth tried to live the Christian life in a worldly way. Paul wrote his first letter to the Corinthians to a divided and self-centered people to remind them to follow Jesus and only Jesus. In this 12-part series, author Jennie Allen walks into the messy lives of the Corinthians and takes us through Paul's words to the conflicted church. We'll see how the truth of the gospel and the Spirit of God can empower us to choose to follow Jesus every day of our lives.
