Dear St. Michael's family,

The St. Michael's Chapter of The Order of the Daughters of the King (DOK) is celebrating six years of prayer and service. Our chapter was instituted six years ago, on January 26, 2014. This Sunday, February 16, at the 11 am service, we will be rededicated. We looking forward to doing so in the midst of our community.

We are a group of Christian women who have adopted a rule of life centered on prayer and service. We meet on the third Sunday of each month at 10:10 am in the Associate Rector's office. Our chapter serves through praying daily, delivering altar flowers to the sick or to others, and assisting with funerals.

The national organization's website gives this overview of what the DOK is all about:

The Order of the Daughters of the King is an order for women who are communicants of the Episcopal Church, churches in communion with it, or churches in the historic episcopate but not in communion with it. The Mission of The Order is the extension of Christ's Kingdom through prayer, service and evangelism. Empowered by the Holy Spirit, our vision as Daughters of the King is to know Jesus Christ, to make Him known to others, and to become reflections of God's love throughout the world. We are a group of Christian women who adopt a Rule of Life based on the promises of our Baptismal Covenant.

Women can become Daughters after a three-month discernment or preparation period. Senior Daughters of the King wear a silver cross inscribed like the one above. The translation of the Latin motto *Magnanimiter Crucem Sustine* is "With heart, mind, and spirit uphold and bear the cross." The "FHS" at the base of the cross stand for the Order's motto, "For His Sake." Junior crosses have only the "FHS" inscribed on them. You can find all this and more on the website: doknational.org.
