


SMEC Outreach Spotlight

ST. MICHAEL'S COMPLETES 3-YEAR PLEDGE TO COMMUNITY FIRST VILLAGE

Recently, St. Michael's completed its 3-year pledge of \$30,000 to Community First Village in East Austin. This gift helped volunteers, like parishioner Ken Choffel, working with CFV, to complete over 60 tiny houses, along with gifts from other generous organizations. St. Michael's continues to partner with Community First Village and Mobile Loaves & Fishes as part of our call of grace and connection to every *one*.






Each house is initially constructed using prefab wall panels and then finished with uniquely colored exteriors, thereby creating a diverse neighborhood of homes. Mark Your Calendars! Trusting in Grace, our Lenten Speaker Series, Starts Sunday, March 6 Our




