SMEC OUTREACH PROJECTS: THE FRUITS OF YOUR GENEROSITY

Earlier this year, thanks to the extravagant generosity of the St. Michael's community, the Outreach Commission approved providing financial support to the following organizations: Seminary of the Southwest, Community First Village, Refugee Services of Texas, Casa Marianella, the Texas Pauli Murray Scholarship, Episcopal Relief and Development, St. Michael's Day School, El Buen Samaritano, Trinity Center, Camp Allen, Honduras Book Project, Del Valle Book project, and our own SMEC garden.

The SMEC garden is a large part of our outreach to our Austin-area neighbors. Half of the winter garden survived the February freeze and has provided a steady harvest of vegetables. For the first quarter of 2021, we delivered *80 bags* of organic vegetables to Manos de Cristo and the Hope Food Pantry at Trinity Church on Speedway. This was only 50% of our normal output! Ken Choffel and others made some needed repairs on the garden infrastructures.





In addition, the Outreach Commission did a book drive at the end of May. They collected 62 adult books for the Inside Books Project, which mails thousands of books each year to Texas inmates, and 65 children's books and 8 art kits for El Buen Samaritano, which provides assistance to the Travis County Latino and Spanish-speaking community. All have been delivered and are much appreciated by the recipients.






NOTES
