

**Successful Refugee Services Drive** For two weeks, St. Michael's collected commodities for Afghan refugees. The narthex table was full of baskets overflowing with the generosity of the parish. Harriet Choffel spread the word before and after services and Annie Wilson, Gail Reid, and Karen Haslund loaded the gifts up. Annie and Karen then delivered over 25 bags of toothbrushes, shampoo, cleaning supplies, and about 15 boxes and large bags of diapers, feminine supplies, and other practical items to Refugee Services of Texas (RST), who were very appreciative. 120 families have been settled in Austin, and more are arriving. They were so grateful for the practical things that not everybody remembers are needed to start a household. RST and the SMEC Outreach Commission offer a heartfelt thank you for your extravagant generosity.
